



## CLUB RULES AND DISCIPLINE

To insure a safe and orderly club meeting, the following rules have been established:

1. Clubbers must behave and show respect to leaders, friends, as well as church property.
2. Clubbers are to remain with their leaders at all times and are not allowed to leave the building without the permission of their leaders.
3. Clubbers are not to bring valuable belongings to club. If your daughter brings a purse, encourage her to not leave it unattended.
4. No electronics. If your child brings a cell phone they must keep it in a bag (Not in their pockets). They will not be allowed to check their phones at Awana. Any phone seen out at Awana will be given to the Commander and returned at the end of the night. If you must reach your child at Awana, please call the church at 913-724-1091.
5. Clubbers must participate in all activities of the club night unless they bring a note from home.
6. Gum chewing and eating candy are not allowed without permission. No Food or Drink in the sanctuary!
7. Clubbers will walk quietly through hallways and common areas at all times. Clubbers will be respectful of all other clubbers who are participating in other activities while transitioning from activity to activity.
8. Climbing on pews is not allowed (including feet on pews).
9. Clubbers are expected to wear their uniform and tennis shoes, and bring their bible and handbook to every club night. If a bible is needed, please speak to a leader.
10. Clubbers must wear their Uniform in order to receive Awards – No Uniform, No Awards.
11. When a leader needs to communicate with clubbers, the leader will give "5" counts. Clubbers must Stop, be Quiet, and Listen for instructions (clubbers should be quiet by "3").
12. Parents and Siblings picking up clubbers: Drive carefully in the parking lot as you come and go each week. There are many children loading and unloading for AWANA and we want to keep them safe and alive.
13. With the exception of Puggles and Cubbies, in the event a clubber is consistently misbehaving, disrespectful, or disruptive, the "3-count" will be administered.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Strike – A warning is given for disruptive behavior.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Strike – For continued disruptive behavior, or any physical contact (No warning will be given). The Club Director intervenes to allow the clubber an opportunity to explain his or her actions and to remind the clubber of the consequences of receiving a "3<sup>rd</sup> strike".
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Strike – Clubber will be taken home by the Commander and another leader and will not be allowed to come back on the next club night. Clubber may return on the second club night after the dismissal.
  - Any clubber dismissed from club a 2<sup>nd</sup> time will be dismissed for the remainder of the club year.
  - The Leader will be given authority to use their best judgment for strikes. There may be times when behavior of the child will necessitate a 2<sup>nd</sup> strike immediately.
